Thank you for your cooperation.




## **Covid Update**

**As a school we are constantly keeping ourselves up to date with the ever-changing climate of the Covid 19 Pandemic. I am writing to you today so that we can ensure that the following latest advice is acted upon from Monday 23rd November.**

**Most of the points are already in place, so this email will serve as a reminder.**

**Bradford are still seeing over 400 new COVID cases a day in the District. So, the measures you are taking to prevent and manage COVID is crucial to reduce community transmission.**

**With that in mind, please may I ask that you maintain social distancing from others when dropping off and collecting your child from school. Wherever possible, please limit this to one adult per family.**

**For those who travel to school by car we ask that you wait in your car until your specific drop off time. This will reduce the amount of people assembling at the gate. Remember to park your car safely and not on double yellow lines, block driveways or park on the pavement.**

**At all times, you must keep at least two metres apart form other parents/ carers and teachers.**
