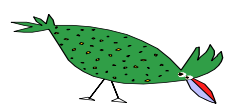
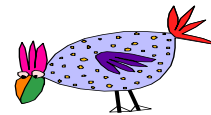
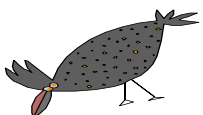
## *Family prayer for the Third Sunday of Ordinary Time*
